

From East or West take I94 to Carmichael Road Exit (Hudson). South at traffic light past shopping area then Dog racing track. Carmichael becomes County Road F. South on F (about 10 miles). Right turn at the 820<sup>th</sup> Ave., then about 2 blocks a left turn into the Park headquarters. If you end up going down a very steep hill, you have gone too far south on F. We will meet down in the park picnic area not by the ranger station. You will go right after the parking lot at the ranger station where you will purchase your park sticker, and keep going till you get to the end of the road (the picnic area). Please do not bring your dogs into the picnic area. Dogs may be exercised on the opposite side of the parking lot from the picnic area.

**State Park Fee**

There is an entry fee of \$7 for Wisconsin residents and \$10 for non-residents which entrants are responsible. The test site is located near Hudson, Wis., 10 miles south of I-94, on Cty. Rd. F.

**Notice to Exhibitors**

Bitches in season may participate in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the tracking regulations, but will run last. The event may be closed due to extreme weather conditions.

**Entry Drawing:**

Entries for this test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing date to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given to those dogs that have not passed a TD test. The drawing will be held Thursday until advertised limit has been drawn. All remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list, corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. The Test Secretary will then notify all entries of the result of the draw. Entry identification, a judging program and directions to the site will be sent to each entrant and alternates. In the event any of the accepted entries cancel or are absent on the day of the test, the Test Secretary will contact the alternates in the order of the drawing. Upon such notification, the alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing entry. If for any reason a dog making the draw is not present or cannot run, the fees will be refunded provided that an alternate competes in their place.

**Certification:** A certification form must accompany each entry. The form must be signed by a person who is accredited by the AKC to judge a tracking test, stating that the dog is ready for such a test. This statement must be dated within 12 months of the date of the Test.

**Test Hours:** Sunday April 27, 2008, 6:00 am to 5:00 pm. The track order will be by lot at 8:00 am. The first track will be run as soon as ready after the draw.

**Risk:** The owner or agent entering a dog in this tracking test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the AKC. Twin Cities Obedience Training Club, Inc. assumes no responsibility for any personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal loss of or damage to any property while at this test or the test site, or in transit to or from the site.
