Move-ups will be added to the end of the running order of the class they move up to. Every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. No verbal changes can be accepted.

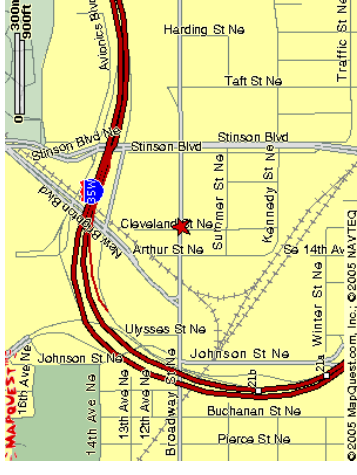

| Sheet Runner: | Take scribe sheets from scribe to score table |
| Leash Runner: | Take leash from start line to finish line |
| Bar Setter: | Reset bars when knocked down and at jump height changes |

| Score Table: | Assist Trial Secretary in scoring documents and data entry |
| Course Builder: | Move obstacles between classes as directed by Chief Course Builder |

ROUTES TO THE AGILITY TRIAL

From the North or South: Take I-35W to Stinson Blvd. exit. Turn south on Stinson and continue to Broadway. Turn right at Broadway and go about 1 block to first driveway on right after the "BREDE" sign. Entrance is in back of building at lower level.

From the East: Take I-94 to Hwy. 280. Go north to Larpenteur Ave/Hennepin Ave and go west. Go north (right) on Stinson Blvd. Turn left on Broadway St. Proceed to 2101 Broadway. Look for "BREDE" sign. Entrance is in back of building at lower level.

From the West: Take I-394 to I-35W north. Take I-35W to Stinson Blvd. exit. Turn south on Stinson and continue to Broadway. Turn right at Broadway and go about 1 block to first driveway on right after the "BREDE" sign. Entrance is in back of building at lower level.



SHOW SITE PARKING

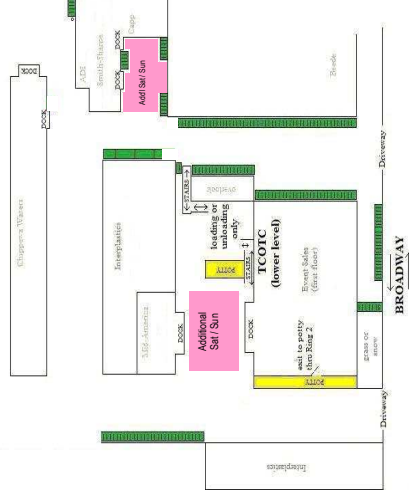
This diagram represents parking that is available. Available spaces are marked in **green**.

Please watch for signs indicating where and where not to park.

There will be additional parking spaces Saturday and Sunday (**pink**) in two locations. Please observe the parking signs as cars parked inappropriately may be towed. No parking in designated **pink** areas on weekdays because businesses are open until 5:00 PM.

Also note the two potty areas (marked in **yellow**). There is an entrance directly to one potty area from Ring 2. **Parking and potty areas will be marked and strictly enforced. Please observe signage for both and keep our neighbors happy! Anyone potting their dogs anywhere except the indicated zones, or off leash, is grounds for dismissal from the trial with no refund of entries. A volunteer will be policing the grounds to ensure compliance.**

Do NOT Leave Your Car Unattended in the Lower Level Loading/Unloading Area for more than a few minutes - This Area is for Loading and Unloading ONLY. No parking (except handicapped and judges) in lower level. There is no overnight parking or hookups available.

FOOD: TCOTC will provide food for this trial.

CRATING SPACE: There is ample crating and chair space in the ring room. Bring as many crates as you want! No crates or personal chairs in the annex, kitchen or Star Room, please. Spectator seating will be provided in the annex.

CRATE GUARDING: Please use common sense when crating reactive dogs and do not crate in a high traffic spot. Be considerate of your neighbor and keep your dog's crate covered. A dog that is consistently a bad neighbor must be crated away from the building.

WARM-UPS: A warm-up area in the Star Room, consisting of an agility jump, will be provided for all exhibitors.

ANNEX LINE-UP AREA: Please help us keep the gate area in the annex clear of congestion and potentially undesirable dog-dog interactions. It is a very close quarters area and should only contain dogs that are running or getting in the queue to run.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles will conform to current requirements of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- Contact surfaces have been rubberized

RINGSIDE: Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Please help your fellow competitors, the trial workers, and the judge by checking in with the gate steward well ahead of your run, and being prompt at the line when your turn comes to run.

SAFETY/BEHAVIOR: The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. **All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.**

LIABILITY: It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Twin Cities Obedience Training Club, INC and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: As it states in the Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 1, Section 3, All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in heat, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Dogs or registerable breeds with accepted foreign registration numbers are eligible to participate.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All measurements are at the dog's withers. Please refer to the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular classes or Preferred Classes with no cross over between them allowed at this same set of trials.

Regular classes

Dogs MAY enter a higher jump height.
8 inches - 11" & under at the withers
12 inches - 14" & under at the withers
16 inches - 18" & under at the withers
20 inches - 22" & under at the withers
24 inches - Over 22" at the withers
26 inches - May be entered at owner's discretion

Preferred Classes

Dogs MAY NOT enter a higher jump height
4 inches - 11" & under at the withers
8 inches - 14" & under at the withers
12 inches - 18" & under at the withers
16 inches - 22" & under at the withers
20 inches - Over 22" at the withers

REFUNDS: Entry fees for bitches that come into season and injured dogs after the closing date will be refunded (minus a \$12.00 administrative fee per day) if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging. A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry. Refunds will not be given for refund amounts of \$ 5 or less. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

WAIT LIST: To fill opening created by entries withdrawn prior to Saturday, February 25 at 6 PM, a Wait List of 25 entries will be established from entries received prior to the Final Closing date. Notification will be sent out after the Final Closing date to verify those entrants wanting to remain on the Wait List if one was established at the Random Draw and for those entries received after the Random Draw date and before the Final Closing date. As openings become available they will be filled from the Wait List. A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by a Wait-Listed entry.

PRIZE AND AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard class and Jumpers With Weaves class. A green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all teams earning a qualifying score. New Title ribbons are available for teams earning a new Title at these trials. A Double Q ribbon is available for those eligible Excellent/B teams. A MACH/PACH rosette and decorated MACH/PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH/PACH. PAX ribbons and decorated bar will be awarded while supplies last. The club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All awards and prizes must be claimed at the show as none will be mailed.

1st Prize: Blue; 2nd Place: Red; 3rd Place: Yellow ; 4th Place: White
Qualifying Ribbon: Dark Green

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
