## Request for Reimbursement of Professional Certifications - 10 minutes

- Behavior Trainer requests reimbursement for the following certification renewals:
- PPG \$70 (renew now)
- APDT \$160 (renew in September)
- IAABC \$85 (renew in September)
- Benefits of maintaining certification: APDT membership allows us to get discounted rates on insurance. Other memberships allow trainer to get discounts on webinars, services and use their advertising materials.
- Total for all three = \$ 315
- o Tonight's objective: review request and respond
- o These are annual expenses
- They also allow her to obtain discounts, such as on future classes or insurance
- Vanessa is still doing consults. She donates her time to the club.
- Helps us differentiate our instructors from others
- Selling point to general public
- Comparable Nosework Certification \$2,000
- Karen moves to approve; Meera seconds

### Status of Expansion Project Planning - 10 minutes

- Any news from conversations with Capp?
- O Any other rental space ideas?
- Need to clearly define who we are and what we want.
- Tenant is nearly moved out, then Capp will get a key to assess
- Capp estimate is higher than what we came up with
  - Main issue is HVAC
  - Need air conditioning, not just air exchange like we currently have downstairs
- Capp getting floor plans for all buildings in this area (4 buildings)
  - Possibility they will put entire complex on market within 2 yrs
  - Their children don't want to deal with buildings, so selling is likely
  - These buildings are likely not usable for modern industrial users
    - Would likely demolish buildings and rebuild
    - So we would still likely need to relocate
    - Could possibly buy us out to proceed with their plans, but would cost them money
- Our Lease is up 06/2025
  - No renewal options we are aware of at this time
  - Fine thru end of lease, but cost may go up with new owner

- Options: Long term lease to protect ourselves if new owner, or start looking for a new place
- The other space we had looked at is now rented
- Suggestion to do both look at new spaces AND renew/refresh/redefine our identity
- Suggestion to hire a Broker both do "leg work" for us, and to negotiate on our behalf
  - Generally a dollar amount dependent upon term of lease, such as a %
  - Suggestion to bring this up at annual meeting, so we can have that in our back pocket
- Anne can talk with Capp further to see if any additional information is forth coming

# Discussion of SCORE Presentation on Branding: Kesha Lien, Brickhouse Consultancy - 30 minutes

- O What did you take away from watching the presentation?
- O Would this framework be a good tool for us to use to begin to chart our course?
  - Seems doable
- o Tonight's objective: identify next steps we want to take and set these in motion.
- Important to know what others think of the organization
  - Particularly those who are not yet members
  - How do we want people to remember/know us?
- Look at what competition has, and how we can differentiate
- Experience of staff is important, and advancement of their own skills
- Age and history of club itself is important
- Suggestion to redefine instructor information and bios
  - Chris will connect with Agility instructors
- Suggestion to hire an actual web developer to fix website
  - Worth the investment
  - Particularly when creating visual representation of our design
  - Current website done in 2015 > it's time to update
  - Would also include social media presence
- Analysis
  - Competitive Top 5
  - Environmental analysis what is our unique position?
  - Then build out brand
- Suggestion to divide into those two buckets
- Suggestion to have these sessions in person
- Suggestion to have moderator/facilitator
  - Keisha's fee for branding = \$800
  - Anne will contact Keisha for options and let us know what she offers
  - Then decide next steps
